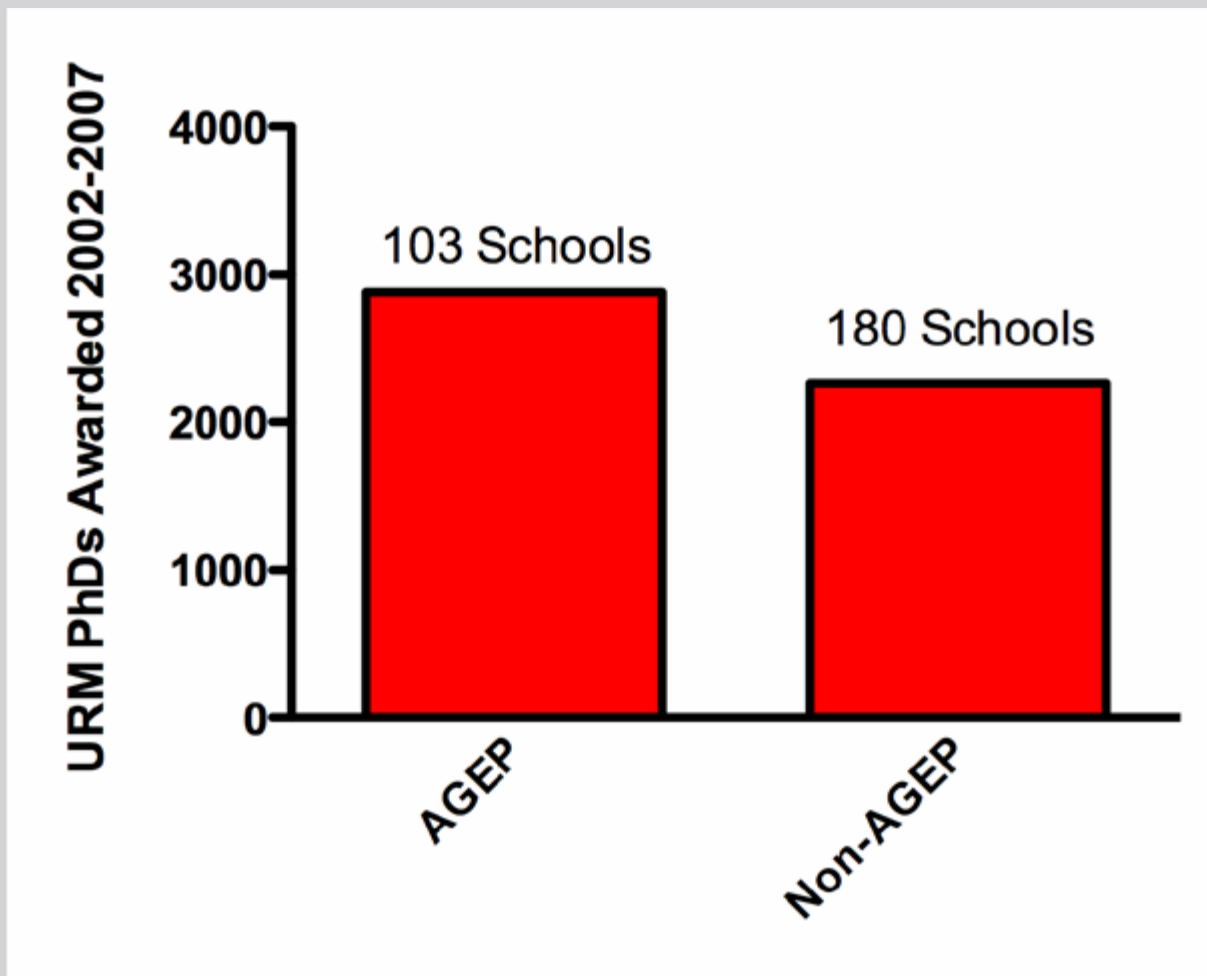
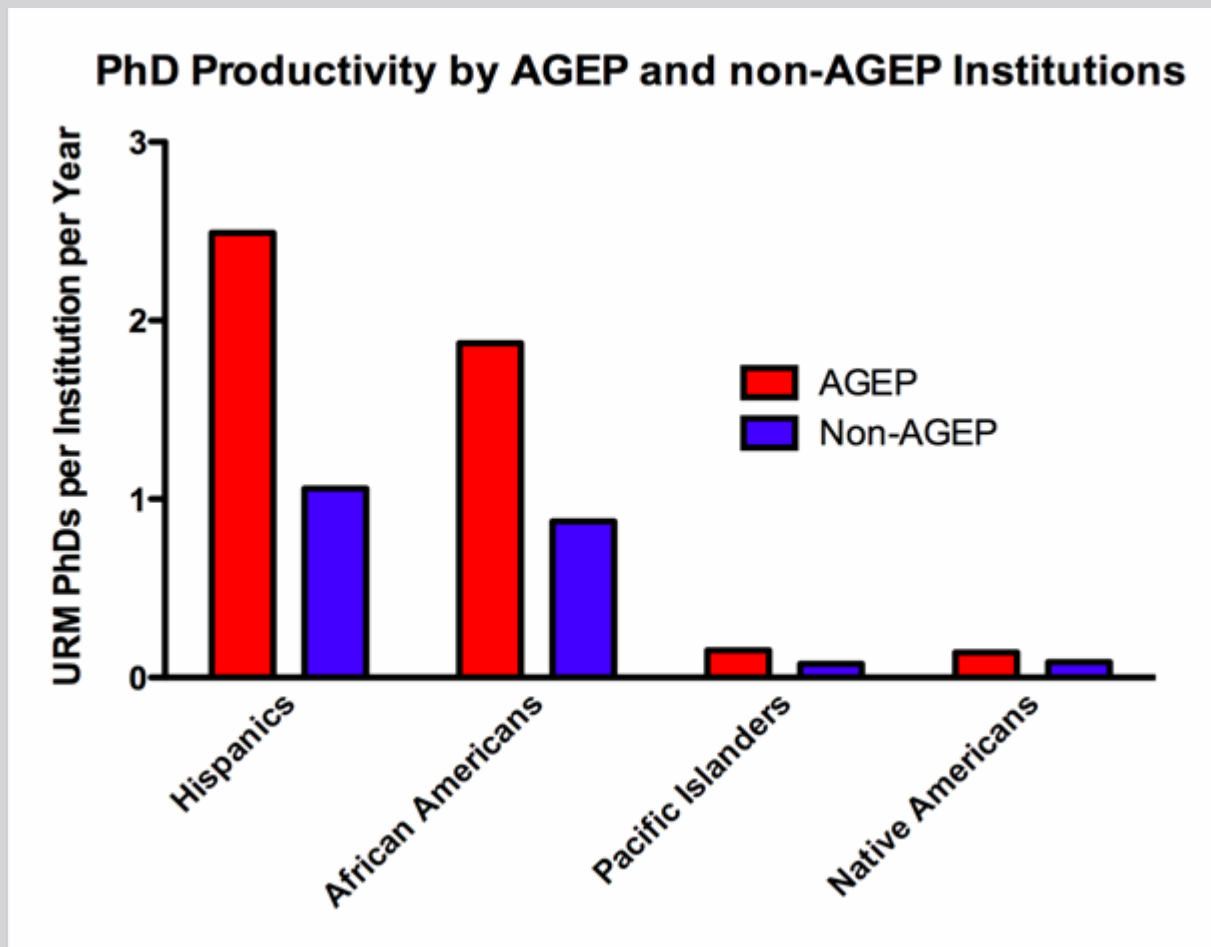


THE GOOD NEWS: AGEP Institutions Produce the Most URM PhDs

America COMPETES Act

Authorizes NSF to establish a new program to award grants on a competitive basis to Hispanic-Serving Institutions in order to *enhance the quality of undergraduate science, technology, engineering, and mathematics education at such institutions and to increase the retention and graduation rates of students pursuing associate or baccalaureate degrees in STEM*



Consultation Process

- Public meeting to request stakeholder input (Washington, DC - March 1, 2009)
- Outreach forum to garner input from STEM faculty at HSIs (Albuquerque, New Mexico - September 25-26, 2009)
- Follow-up workshop for STEM faculty from 84 HSIs (Las Vegas, Nevada - December 4-5, 2009)



Disadvantaged Males

- HRD is examining issues associated with recruitment and retention of disadvantaged males (**Male Academic Enhancement**)
- HBCU-UP encourages PIs to consider inclusion of research and implementation strategies to address the challenges such individuals face

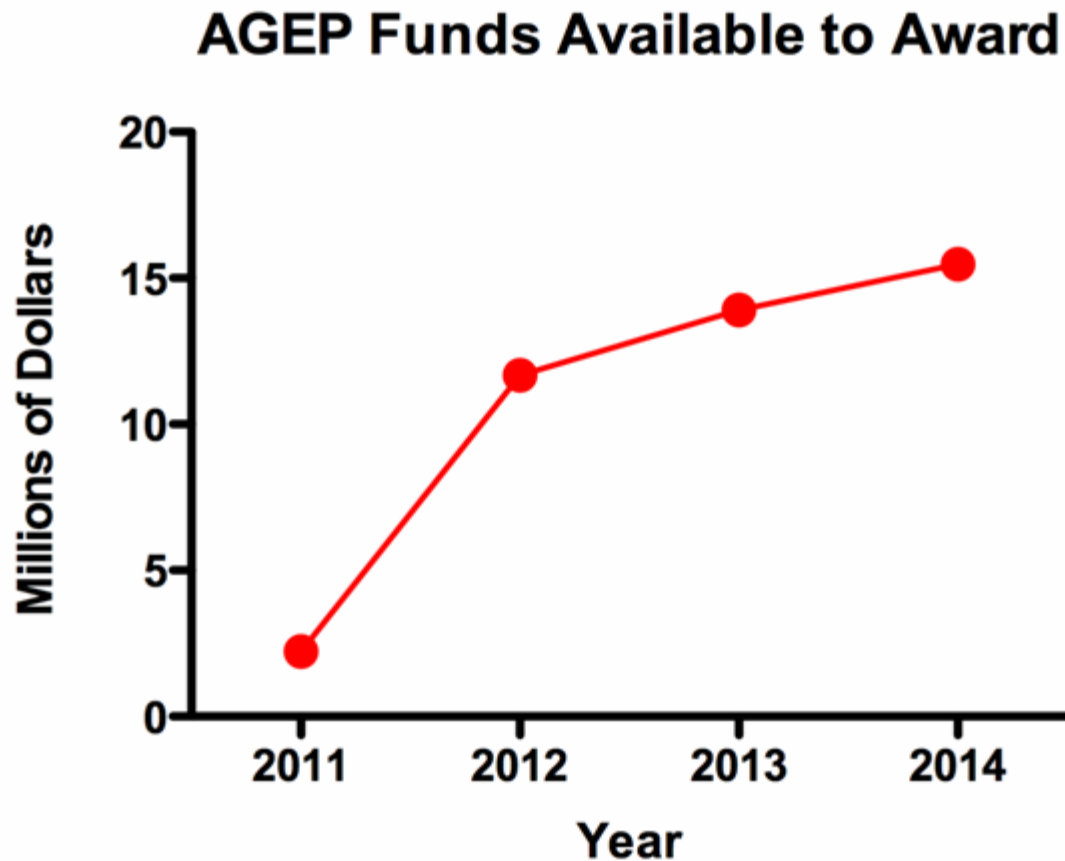


AGEP II Transition Modeling: A New Research Track?

- PhD to Postdoctoral (ID, database, tracking, *etc.*)
- Postdoctoral to Faculty Position (the network)
- Early Faculty Enhancement (CAREER, *etc.*)
- FY2011 Funding (\$2.2M/ 7 awards at \$300K each)
- FY2012-14 Funding (\$12, 14, 15M) = \$41M
